US Highway 50 (east or west)

-Turn south on Eastland Drive (on the east side of Jefferson City). If you are coming from the west (Sedalia) you will turn right, from the east (Linn) you will turn left.

-Continue south on Eastland Drive (you will pass several banks, McDonalds, and Pizza Hut) to the four-way stop at Bald Hill Road.

-Turn left onto Bald Hill Road. The farm is located at 3804 Bald Hill Road, several miles past the four-way stop.

US Highway 63 (coming from the north/Columbia)

NOTE US-63 S joins with US-54 W before crossing the Missouri River until you reach the intersection where US-63 S then joins with US-50 E.

- If coming from the north, stay on 63 S until you have passed this intersection and are on US-50 E/US-63 S.
- Turn south (right) on Eastland Drive (on the east side of Jefferson City).
- Continue south on Eastland Drive (you will pass several banks, McDonalds, and Pizza Hut) to the four-way stop at Bald Hill Road.
- Turn left onto Bald Hill Road. The farm is located at 3804 Bald Hill Road, several miles past the four-way stop.

From US Highway 63 (coming from the south/Rolla)

- Turn south (left) on Eastland Drive (on the east side of Jefferson City).
- Continue south on Eastland Drive (you will pass several banks, McDonalds, and Pizza Hut) to the four-way stop at Bald Hill Road.
- Turn left onto Bald Hill Road. The farm is located at 3804 Bald Hill Road, several miles past the four-way stop.

US Highway 54 (coming from the east/Mexico):

- Take the US-50 E/US-50 W/US-63 S exit and bear left onto the US-50 E/US-63 S ramp.
- Continue on US-50 E/US-63 S until you reach Eastland Drive.
- Turn south (right) on Eastland Drive (on the east side of Jefferson City).
- Continue south on Eastland Drive (you will pass several banks, McDonalds, and Pizza Hut) to the four-way stop at Bald Hill Road
- Turn left onto Bald Hill Road. The farm is located at 3804 Bald Hill Road, several miles past the four-way stop.

US Highway 54 (coming from the west/Eldon):

- Take the Ellis Blvd exit and turn right onto Ellis Boulevard
- Continue on Ellis Boulevard (NOTE - the name of the road changes to Seven Hills Road after you cross Greenberry Road) until the four-way stop at Bald Hills Road
- Turn right at the four-way stop onto Bald Hills Road
- The farm is located at 3804 Bald Hill Road, several miles past the four-way stop.
